TOGETHER WE ARE STRONGER!

Even with the works suspended in all the churches, our institution continues to honor its social and **environmental obligations**. We provide assistance and income for workers and residents in our communities, and continue to care for the gardens to guarantee the production of our Sacrament. We count on the support of our associates by means of monthly dues to give continuity to the work of Padrinho Sebastião.



The final step is underway in **reinforcing the foundation** of the new church, with workers that arrived in Mapiá prior to the implementation of the social isolation guidelines. ICEFLU continues to evaluate the situation of the pandemic in Brazil in order to understand and be able to define the next steps.

TOGETHER WE WILL BE VICTORIOUS!

In addition to the constant community meetings and emergency projects, many tasks are being undertaken in the village:

Distribution of masks and sanitizer with family visits; installation of a gate at the entrance to the Mapiá river; negotiations with the Public Benefits office in Boca do Acre for receipt of government stimulus funds for families; and registration of all those who are eligible for emergency assistance from the Federal Government.



HEALTH IN THE VILLAGE



With support from our brother **Robert Wooton**, the remodeling of the Medical Clinic and the construction of the Dental Clinic have been completed. The pharmacy, medical consultation room and endemic disease lab have yet to be fully equipped. With support from the irmandade, the AmaGaia program and the Nova Era Institute, we are articulating improvements so that the Medical Clinic can function as a comprehensive basic healthcare facility.



EMERGENCY CAMPAIGN

The **Mapiá Residents' Healthcare Committee** and the Santa Casa have launched an emergency campaign to support Vila Céu do Mapiá and Fazenda São Sebastião, focused on actions for prevention and management of the pandemic. The acquisition of medications and equipment for the village Medical Clinic has been planned, along with improvements in the infrastructure of the Santa Casa and a social assistance fund.

VIVA OUR FLOUR PRODUCTION!

Céu do Mapiá has planned a series of grain milling projects to produce flour to guarantee the basic community food supply in these times of crisis. The first of these was at the grain mill of the Community Farmers, where all of the manioc is planted and cultivated in community cooperation. **300kg of special flour** and 40kg of prepared tapioca were produced. Several other milling events are planned, in conjunction with the COOPERAR Agro-ecology and Dietary Sustainability workgroup.



PRESERVING OUR HISTORY

In these times of the pandemic, with the support of the **Nova Era Institute**, the CEDOC team has resumed its activities. Over the past year, approximately eight thousand items have been catalogued and registered in detail. This year, one goal is the preservation of over 300 photos related to Padrinho Sebastião and Céu do Mapiá that will undergo special treatment to be included in the upcoming publications from Yagé Publishing.

MAPIÁ IN THE GLOBAL ECOVILLAGE NETWORK

The Global Ecovillage Network invited **Céu do Mapiá** to share its experiences with confronting climate change and the COVID-19 pandemic in an interview that will be published on its social media networks. Our community was created by Padrinho Sebastião to prepare for the 'shaking', living a simple life in the forest, planting our own food and nourished by our spiritual practice.





COCOA HARVEST 2020

The **Agroextractivist Cooperative** of Mapiá and the Middle Purus is undertaking the 2020 harvest of native cocoa in three locations: RESEX Arapixi, Fazenda São Sebastião and Realeza. This cocoa, internationally recognized for its quality, will be used in the production of cocoa butter and cocoa powder by Cooperar and will be sold to industries in Brazil and worldwide, including Europe, Japan and the United States.

TUNING IN TO THE CENTENNIAL

During this quarantine, Radio Jagube has been transmitting recordings of hinários and concentrations, as well as music and interviews. Over 70,000 visitors have been registered at our Web Radio site, which was only launched just over a month ago. The Radio has been an important tool for us to remain connected and to keep the divine flame of our spirituality lit.

WORK ONLINE

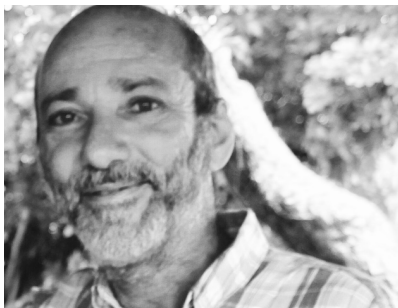

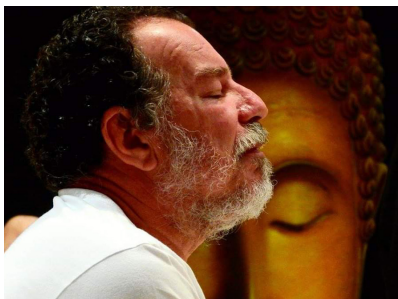
LIGHT AND COMFORT FOR THE FAMILY AND COMMUNITY
